Manufacturing Skills Australia (MSA) is the national body responsible for ensuring that manufacturing enterprises have the workforce skills they need to be globally competitive now and into the future. We work with enterprises, employer and industry associations, trade unions and industry advisory bodies to identify what skills are needed and how these can most effectively be implemented in industry. We are a national Industry Skills Council, owned by industry and managed by a board from across industry, funded by the Australian Government through the Department of Industry.

What we do:

- develop and maintain national, industry endorsed Training Packages - to establish skill standards and provide a framework for skills development
- support the implementation of training - through advice and resources, and brokerage of Australian Government funded programs
- provide leadership to support economic and environmental sustainability
- provide government with industry intelligence - to inform the development of policies and programs aimed at workforce development.
